The Apostles:		the Truth	v 29-32
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- Did not change their convictions .
- Did not change their message .
- Did not change their lifestyle .

Gamaliel: the Truth v 33-39

- He rejected the evidence •
- He assumed history would repeat itself ٠ (given time the effort will fade)
- He remained in neutral when a decision was necessary ٠

The Church: the Truth v 40-42

- Persecution did not stop them from witnessing ٠
- They balanced proclamation with instruction • (what to believe and why)
- Christ remained the topic of their preaching/teaching
